This month we want to recognize and pay tribute to **Dave Montgomery**, who after nearly 20 years of dedicated service and outstanding leadership has decided to retire from his full-time position with Valco. Fortunately though, Dave has moved to a part-time consulting position where he will work on special projects on an add needed basis.

Dave started with Valco on June 24, 2004, as General Manager and over the years took on many different roles and positions with the company. Dave was born and raised in Dayton, Ohio and graduated from Oakwood High School. Dave then enrolled in a five-year co-op program at the University of Cincinnati and graduated with an electrical engineering degree. After getting his degree from Cincinnati, Dave was accepted to Harvard Graduate School of business and received his MBA in manufacturing with an emphasis on finance.



In 1967, Dave joined The Sheffield Division of Bendix Corporation in Dayton as manager of production and inventory control. After a few years he became the engineering manager at Sheffield. In 1976, Dave became president and CEO of Dayton Machine Tool Company, which was a family-owned business that specialized in the design, development, and building of specialized machines for government, aerospace, and automotive industries. Over the years Dayton Machined Tool developed partnerships and customers in numerous countries throughout the world. The company sold in January 2004, which of course turned out to be a very good thing for Valco! Dave has been married to Judy for some 60 years and has one son, David who is an attorney in Dayton and three grandchildren. He has been very active in a number of organizations, such as Dayton Opera, Dayton Art Institute, Engineering and Science Foundation, Association of Manufacturing Technology to name a few.

It certainly has been an amazing and satisfying journey over the last 20 years and I will always be grateful to Dave for his dedication, leadership, expertise, and friendship as we worked together to improve and grow Valco into an employee-owned company we can all be very proud of. Dave's calm demeanor and leadership were invaluable in February 2007 when we experienced a devastating fire that destroyed one of our facilities and all the equipment in that facility. Dave was an intricate part of leading the effort that had Valco relocated into a new facility and back operating by May 2007. He helped us rise from the ashes so to speak. Dave also was part of the leadership team that transitioned Valco from being privately owned for some 35 years into an Employee Stock Ownership Plan (ESOP) company in March of 2021.

Valco is thrilled to still have Dave's experience, expertise, dedication, and commitment on a part-time advisory basis. Valco, our employee owners, and I thank Dave for all he has done and accomplished over the past 20 years. "We certainly have come a long way baby." Well done Dave and very much appreciated.
