In late November, Valco partnered with Springfield City Schools to offer English as a Second Language (ESL)

instruction to a number of our associates. A total of 15 associates completed five hours of testing to determine individual levels of English fluency in both speaking and reading.

Based on the results, two associates tested out of the program, three were placed in ESL classes at a nearby city school just minutes from Valco, and ten associates are currently taking classes on-site at Valco. A Springfield City Schools teacher visits Valco twice a week, providing two-hour sessions each visit.

So far, the program has been very successful. Attendance and participation have been excellent, and everyone is making great progress. We're proud to offer this additional support to our associates and truly see this partnership as a win-win for our team, our community, and Valco.
